

ANTARCTICA ROUTES

Antarctica and the Sub-Antarctic Islands are some of the last unspoiled wildernesses on our planet. The Weddell Sea is mostly ice-clogged with huge tabular icebergs. Snow-capped mountains are towering from the sea with hundreds of glaciers. Wildlife is abundant: penguins, whales, seals and sea birds. Crossing the Antarctic Circle to reach the most Southerly position brings polar history back to life.



ANTARCTIC PENINSULA

The Antarctic Peninsula is one of the most beautiful regions of the entire continent. Your cruise to the Antarctic Peninsula will reveal the most diverse mixture of wildlife throughout Antarctica. The prevalence of penguins is a highlight during most expeditions, and a visit during the summer can even reveal plant life such as the area's only two flowering plants: the Antarctic pearlwort and Antarctic hair grass.



ATLANTIC ODYSSEY

The Mid Atlantic Islands are the remotest places on earth to reach. There is a wide variety of wildlife South and North of the Antarctic Convergence.

INTERESTED IN CREATING YOUR OWN POLAR TRAVEL STORY?



(*) HIKING / SNOWSHOEING

We offer easy, moderate and more demanding walks in the vicinity of the landing sites to suit everyone's capability. Rubber boots for hiking will be provided. Snowshoes are available free of charge for everyone on board and fit all boot sizes.





(A) ZODIAC CRUISING & SHORE PROGRAM

Guided shore excursions, walks, wildlife spotting and zodiac cruises are included in the cruise fare and will be offered to all passengers during all voyages. We put our emphasis on active wildlife and nature experience. We take advantage of wildlife opportunities by using our zodiacs for both landings and cruises.







CAMPING

In Antarctica we offer "open-air" camping, a rare opportunity to sleep under the stars for a unique Antarctic wilderness experience. Special equipment will be provided. The camping group will be taken ashore after dinner and returned to the ship just before breakfast.



X KAYAKING

On selected voyages we offer kayaking, which is available for everyone. Special kayak gear will be provided: single- and double-seat kayaks, neoprene wet suits, life vests. A kayak guide will supervise the activity, kayakers will be accompanied by a safety Zodiac boat.







SKI MOUNTAINEERING

Activity for experienced ski mountaineers. Ski mountaineers climb and ski in sometimes steep, deep snow-covered, glaciated and potentially dangerous alpine environment. Certified mountain guides are responsible for the safety of the group.








DIVING

Activity for advanced divers experienced in dry-suit, cold-water diving. Dive team leaders and dive guides are responsible for safety during operation. Basic equipment is available on board (scuba tanks, compressors, weights and diving essentials). Divers bring their own personal gear.



MOUNTAINEERING

A more technical and strenuous activity for those who wish to summit viewpoints under the leadership of a certified mountain guide. Physical fitness and mountaineering boots are essential. Special glacier equipment will be provided: ropes and carabiners, harnesses, helmets, ice axes and crampons. Max. group size per guide: 6.







HELICOPTER FLIGHTS

On selected Ortelius voyages we use helicopters to get even closer to the heart of untouched wildlife, allowing to set foot onto some of the world's most remote landscapes. Take a flight above the ice of the Weddell Sea or Ross Sea and enjoy the magnificent scenery of the Antarctic wilderness.






8 PHOTO WORKSHOP

On some voyages we offer photo workshops for beginners and advanced under the supervision of a photo expert on board. Participants learn about objects, exposures, photo composition and basic rules of photography in photo lectures and during landing days.



OUR ARCTIC ROUTES



SPITSBERGEN

Spitsbergen is the land of the midnight sun, snow, pack ice, and the king of the Arctic, the Polar Bear! Rugged mountains, lush tundra glaciers and a wealth of maritime wildlife and hundreds of thousands of seabirds give this region its unique character. Oceanwide Expeditions operates in Spitsbergen from April until October.



NORTH NORWAY

North Norway cruises carry you into a picturesque land dominated by thousands of kilometres of coastland and blanketed by the beauty of the Northern Lights. The waters are home to all sorts of whales. Oceanwide Expeditions operates in North Norway from November until March.





GREENLAND

East Greenland and the inner fjords open their icy gateway and become accessible by ship and zodiacs. Colors change dramatically in autumn, mountains stick out from the sea and sunsets slowly fade into pitch dark nights when the Aurora Borealis (Northern Lights) glow bright in the night sky.

EXPEDITION VESSELS

Oceanwide Expeditions owns and operates a modern fleet of small ice-strengthened expedition vessels: m/v Plancius, m/v Ortelius, s/v Rembrandt van Rijn and s/v Noorderlicht, and, launching in 2019, m/v Hondius. Our ships offer a comfortable on-board hotel product. The luxury lies in the field, being outdoors.


